

An amendment to require payment to schools for IQT tournaments before competing at TFA State.

Add on Page 86 of the Constitution under Entry and Eligibility:

“11. In order for a school to be eligible for competition in the state meet, that school needs to have fully paid tournament dues to member schools that hosted IQT invitationals in which they attended. Schools that have disputes of payment after the IQT season shall provide a list of unpaid schools to the President of TFA. If there is a dispute on payment, the school owing money will need to show proof of payment to the President for verification.”

Rationale: At the end of the IQT season, there were a number of complaints about schools that had not paid for IQT tournaments. Many schools use this money for travel to events such as the state meet. Requiring payment before a school competes at state would seem fair as it is hard to collect after the state tournament since that is the finale of the season.
