S/He will also be responsible for scanning ballots (if this option is available) at the TFA State Tournament. S/He will also be responsible for maintaining the purchasing and distribution of TFA merchandise. This person will be a non-voting member of the TFA Executive Council.

ADD LINES

PRESIDENTIAL ADVISOR This position will be appointed by the TFA President (at the same time and through the same process as the IQT Coordinator), and shall serve for one year. This individual will serve in the capacity seen fit by the President in order to promote the agenda to which the

President was elected or as the needs of the State direct. This person will be a non-voting member of the TFA Executive Council.
