

An Amendment to Alter The Number of Tournaments Hosted in a Weekend

Under Hosting an Invitational Qualifying Tournament - #10

Add the underlined -

10. A maximum of two tournaments per region can be scheduled on the same weekend, with the exceptions of tournaments being 150+ miles apart within a region or when all possible tournament slots have been filled by other schools. When 150+ miles apart, from the closest hosting school, a region may host up to four tournaments per weekend. When there are more applicants in a region than available calendar spots and the 150+ mile rule cannot apply, regions can offer 3 tournaments on a weekend. Conflicts will be resolved by application of the above priorities.

Rationale - The metroplexes of Texas are getting larger and larger. The number of tournament spots is limited based on our calendar. There are currently schools that are being boxed out of hosting a tournament because of slot availability. There is a belief that these metroplexes are getting so large that there is capacity to offer 3 tournaments on a weekend. This will give budding programs the opportunity to fundraise from tournaments just as established tournaments do.

This amendment will go into effect immediately upon passage. Schools that wish to take advantage for this year will have to quickly alert their region reps if passed so that approval for their tournament can be put on the agenda under region business.
