

An Amendment Regarding World Schools Numbers

Under World Schools Debate #11

Eliminate the year.

11. Minimum IQT requirements and qualification numbers for World Schools Debate **in the 2018-19 school year**: the minimum number of WS entries for an IQT to award qualification points would be 6 teams. IQTs must offer a minimum of 3 preliminary rounds (one being an impromptu motion) with the following required elimination rounds:

Rationale - The state voted in world schools as an event and while it is thriving in some parts of the state it still needs some help in others. Additionally with a team being anywhere from 3-5 people, there could potentially be 30 people competing with just 6 teams. This is more participation than the minimum qualifying numbers in CX or PF at the lowest level of 10.

This amendment will go into effect immediately upon passage and schools hosting meets before convention will be credited based on the number of entries starting at 6.
