

Judge Fee / Judge Payment Form for IQT's

Directions: In order to provide protection for both hired judges and schools paying judge fees, schools shall be required to submit a form indicating collected judge fees and payment out to judges.

The Constitution prohibits the profit of tournaments off of judging fees. These fees should be paid out to judges.

Please indicate the amount of judge fees collected below along with the total amount paid out to judges at the tournament. Please note that if a judge cancels the day of the tournament it is NOT the expectation of the school to adjust contracts to judges based on the drop of a judge. Additionally, if a school drops a judge and has to pay additional fees, that fee would also not have to be factored into a reallocation of judge contracts.

This form is due to the TFA State Treasurer by May 1st and is encouraged to be submitted with the application to host next year. If a school does not plan on hosting in the following year they are still required to submit this judge fee / judge payment form. Swing tournaments can submit one form if payment is solely from one school.

If a school has a concern and inquires about how funds were spent, additional documentation might be requested.
